8. How many wires and what size for the 4" control valve from the main pump station?

ANSWER: Install new conduit and wire for 400-amp service to the new location on the opposite side of the lake. Distance up to 425' from existing transformer and meter base. 4" cla valve and 3 - #14 gauge wires from pump station to vault.

9. The pump houses and the irrigation do not need a permit from Area Plan.
