Evansville's economy was booming shortly after the turn	of							
the century, and these good times gave rise to a number of	new							
businesses and buildings. John O'Donnell, proprietor of the								
Sanitary Plumbing Company, moved into premises he had recen	tly							
purchased on Sixth Street in 1905. O'Donnell, a "specialis	t"							
in steam and hot water heating, however, made substantial i	m-							
provements to the building some six years later in the spr	ing							
of 1911. At that time, he commissioned architect Harry E. B	oyle							
to remodel thestore. A second story was added of pressed b	rick							
and stone trimmings (to be used for apartments) and a new p	late							
glass front was installed. Little or no change has occurre	d to							
the front elevation of the O'Donnell building. Even the								
prism glass transom across the front is still present. Bet	ween							
1915 and 1920, O'Donnell moved his business to a Main Stree	t							
site; hoever, the property stayed in the family until purch	ased							
by the Bethurams in 1945.
