November 2, 2020 - November 16, 2020

Open Enrollment will be held November 2nd through November 16th. The benefit choices you make during Open Enrollment will be effective January 1, 2021 and remain in place through *December 31, 2021*. Once Open Enrollment has closed, benefits can only be changed if you have experienced a HIPAA Qualifying Event <u>AND</u> make an appointment with the Auditor's Office within 30 days of that event. You must also provide appropriate documentation.

If you have a qualifying event and do not provide documentation to Leslie Saiko or Daniela Whitney within 30 days, you will have to wait until the next Open Enrollment to make changes.

SUBMITTING OPEN ENROLLMENT CHANGES: All changes to insurance during open enrollment will need to be submitted to the Auditor's Office on the appropriate application(s). All forms must be received no later than November 16, 2020.

INPRS/PERF Rate: The Employer Contribution Rate for 2021 will be 11.2% of your gross wages. This is the amount that Vanderburgh County contributes towards your county pension and will remain the same as the 2020 rate.
