Dear Property Owner:

In 2005, the City of Evansville adopted a sidewalk policy that allows property owners the opportunity to participate in the cost of having their sidewalks repaired. You have received this letter because our office has a request on file from you or a concerned citizen requesting sidewalk repairs at this address.

Under this policy, petitioners may be eligible to have their sidewalks replaced on a 50% property owner/50% city cost sharing basis for petitions submitted after January 1, 2006. A copy of the final ordinance which established this policy has been enclosed with this letter and includes full details of the program.


To participate in this cost sharing program, you must complete the petition provided and mail it to the following address:

Also, you must be the owner of record for the abutting property to the sidewalk for which you are requesting repair. Included in this program is a provision for property owners to petition for full block replacement of sidewalks.

This petition is not binding, but serves as the first step in determining if the sidewalk for which repair is being requested meets the minimum criteria. Property owners will be notified once your property is placed on a contract for sidewalk repairs, cost estimates will be prepared and public hearings will be held.
