



## DEPARTMENT OF PARKS & RECREATION POOL ADMITTANCE & GROUP USAGE POLICIES

### **Admittance Policy**

1. All swimmers 7 years of age and younger must be accompanied by a responsible party 16 years of age or older.
2. A person who is not a parent or legal guardian may accompany no more than 4 children 7 years of age or younger to a pool at one time.
3. Swim diapers are required for all children not potty trained. Swim diapers can be purchased for \$1.00 from the cashier.

### **Group Usage Policy**

1. All groups will be required to maintain the required minimum adult to child ratios as set by the Department of Parks and Recreation in order to enter and use the facility. Youth ages 5 and under require 1 adult for every 5 children. Youth ages 6 and older require 1 adult for every 10 children. Groups who do not have the proper adult to child ratio will be turned away at the door. Please be sure you have the proper ratio prior to arriving.
2. Adult chaperones will be responsible for continually supervising and monitoring the children in their group at all times while in the Aquatic Facility. Adult chaperones must have appropriate swimwear attire and be actively supervising their children in the pool and on the pool deck.
3. Groups of 15 or more must call 48 hours in advance to be guaranteed admittance. Group time slots are popular and limited so please call early for the best availability and selection.
4. Group leaders must complete a group usage information form for each pool visit. This form will verify that the minimum adult to child supervision ratio is met. This form will also require the group leader to confirm the exact number of children under their care when entering and leaving the facility for the day.
5. Each group will meet with the Pool Manager or Head Lifeguard to review pool rules.
6. Groups will be limited to a 2 hour time slot with a maximum number of children per booking determined by individual pool capacity.
7. Group bookings are available MONDAY – FRIDAY ONLY and may be limited to non-prime hours.
8. Please call at least 24 hours in advance to cancel a booking.
