## GENERAL CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

The Common Council of the City of Evansville is now accepting nominations for members of the Affordable Housing Fund Advisory Committee in reference to Municipal Code 3.35.040. These individuals must be nominated to the City Council after a general call for nominations from township trustees, community development corporations, neighborhood associations, community based organizations, and other social services agencies to represent the community at large.

The Affordable Housing Fund Advisory Committee shall make recommendations to the City regarding the development of policies and procedures for the uses of the Affordable Housing Fund and long-term sources of capital for the Affordable Housing Fund, including revenue from development ordinances, fees, taxes, financial market based income, revenue derived from private sources and revenue generated from grants, gifts, donations, or income in any other form from a government program, foundation or corporation.
