- **Announcements and Updates**

- On 8/7/10, Computer Services completed maintenance of the VAX that involved bringing the VAX down and back up to install a tape drive for backups.
- On 8/12/10, Bill Fluty gave an update to the ITAC Board and reported that July 1, 2013 is the projected date for the retirement of the VAX. Plans to work on obtaining funding for the County Financial and Payroll at the County 2011 Budget Hearings.
- On 8/16/10, Candy Nance of the Treasurer's Office sent an email to Computer Services on errors received on the current Inheritance Tax Program and reporting that the program is not calculating correctly and may affect their quarterly report to the state.
- On 8/17/10, Matt Arvay asked for funding to follow the City with Tyler Technologies for the County Financial and Payroll applications (MUNIS).

- Other updates and concerns:
  - Dave and John said that the maintenance on the VAX that was done on 8/7/10 to install the tape drive was more involved than what they had anticipated; ran into scheduling problems due to active programs on the VAX.
  - Bill said that hopefully we can move all the active programs off the VAX and leave the historical data on the VAX for storage.
  - Dave said that he needs to get Zeus retired and moved to Naples as Zeus PC.
  - Dave asked Tim about Ritz on Naples; said that he received a call to allow someone back on Earth; she had said that not all records were moved to Courtview and that they needed access; had emailed Tim to find out what data she can't find; Tim said that he would find out; might need an extra level of review.
