- **Announcements and Updates**

- On 9/9/10, Bill Fluty gave an update to the ITAC Board.
- On 9/8/10, the County Council approved funding for the Tyler Technologies MUNIS financial/ payroll application; county attorney and CIO setting up contract; implementation can begin as soon as 1/1/11 when the funding becomes available.
- Karen said that neither Ben Miller nor Kelly Giles would be able to attend this meeting; Dave said that John Staples was tied up in another meeting; Bill said that Chief Deputy Joe Gries was to attend this meeting but had to leave the office this afternoon; Tracy Moore came as the representative for the County Clerk's Office; no one had heard from Elizabeth Barnes.
- Bill stated that funding had been acquired to purchase the MUNIS financial and payroll applications for the County in 2011; said that money was funded from the CCD fund and not the County General Fund.
- Wants the CIO Matt Arvay to contact the County Attorney Ted Ziemer and meet with Tyler Technologies to sign a contract; tie up any loose ends so that it will be ready to sign by the Commissioners in January 2011.
- Said that the City plans to go live with their financial on 1/11/11; hopes that the County can follow with their financial going live on 1/1/12 and with payroll on 1/1/13.
- Bill said that sometime in November of 2010 he plans to step aside and that the committee can move forward with another chair.
