A project is in progress or scheduled to begin soon in these areas:

Presidents Neighborhood

In progress. Est. completion 5/2020. Installing 21,000 feet of new water main pipe and 30 hydrants.

Broadway Avenue

In progress. Est. completion 7/2020. Installing 11,000 feet of new water main pipe and 26 hydrants.

First Avenue

Begins 5/2020. Installing 7,900 feet of new water main pipe from Morgan Ave. to Colonial Ave.

Columbia-Fares

Begins Summer 2020. Installing 9,000 feet of new water main pipe and upgrades throughout the area.
