EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2020-3

An Executive Order Rescinding the Requirement to Use Face Masks within the City of Evansville

WHEREAS, on July 15, 2020, I issued Executive Order 2020-1 (the "Order"), in response to the local increase of positive COVID-19 cases, ordering all persons in the City to wear face masks, unless otherwise excepted;

WHEREAS, on July 22, 2020, I issued Executive Order 2020-2, which renewed and extended the Order for a period of seven (7) days;

WHEREAS, on July 27, 2020, the Governor of Indiana issued Executive Order 20-37, effective for a period of thirty (30) days, that requires all persons in the State of Indiana to wear a face covering in public spaces when a distance of six (6) feet cannot be maintained between another person not in the same household, subject to certain exceptions; ("State Face Covering Requirement");

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.150.110 of the Evansville Municipal Code provides that executive orders of the Mayor must be consistent with and subordinate to orders made by the Governor;

WHEREAS, the need for the local mask requirement has been thoroughly addressed by the State Face Covering Requirement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me as the Mayor of the City, I hereby rescind Executive Order 2020-1 and Executive Order 2020-2 and instruct all City residents to comply with the State Face Covering Requirement.

This Executive Order will be filed with the City Clerk pursuant to Indiana Code § 10-14-3-29(a) and Chapter 2.150.110(B)(2)(a) of the Evansville Municipal Code.




