PUBLIC NOTICE DECLARATION OF "OPEN BURNING EMERGENCY"

The Board of Commissioners of Vanderburgh County, in order to protect the public welfare and safety during this unusually dry period, and with the advisory issued by the City of Evansville/Vanderburgh County Emergency Management Agency, and pursuant to Chapter 8.12 of the Vanderburgh County Code of Ordinances, hereby proclaims an extension of the OPEN BURN EMERGENCY issued October 21, 2022. This ban shall be in effect for all unincorporated areas of Vanderburgh County and valid 24 hours a day. The ban shall run for 30 days or until rescinded, whichever date is earlier.

No person shall set, start or attempt to set, or allow to continue, an open fire within the County unless he or she has first obtained and has in his or her possession a written permit from the commanding office of the fire department having primary jurisdiction over the area where the open fire is to be conducted. Any person deemed guilty of a violation of this declaration, and upon conviction, shall be fined \$500.
