Vanderburgh County Awarded Community Crossings Matching Grant

Evansville, IN. (December 8, 2022) – The Board of Commissioners are pleased to announce Vanderburgh County will receive \$657,378.00 in state matching funds for local road projects through Community Crossings, a component of Governor Eric Holcomb’s Next Level Roads program.

Vanderburgh County was one of 229 Indiana cities, towns, and counties that received more than a combined \$119 million. The City of Evansville was also a recipient.

Road projects include:

- 1. Hogue Road between Peerless Road and the CSX tracks east of Rosenberger Avenue**
- 2. New Harmony Road between University Parkway and Diamond Avenue**

INDOT’S Community Crossings Matching Grant program provides funding to cities, towns, and counties across Indiana so that they may invest in improvements to local roads and bridges. These infrastructure enhancements assist Hoosier communities in driving economic development, creating jobs, and strengthening local transportation networks. The state has awarded over \$1 billion in state funds since 2016 to support local road and bridge projects throughout Indiana.
