Vanderburgh County Commissioners Announce Closure of Storm Debris Disposal at Burdette Park

EVANSVILLE, IN – April 15, 2024 – The storm debris disposal site at Burdette Park, established in response to the recent storm damage in Vanderburgh County, will close effective today, April 15, 2024, at 4:00 p.m. CST. The site will no longer accept any materials, and residents are encouraged to explore alternative disposal options for any remaining storm debris.

Bids for the cleanup and disposal of the storm debris will be initiated at the Board of Commissioners' next regularly scheduled meeting on April 23, 2024.
