CMMS for Tracking Operating and Maintenance Activities

Dear Mr. Bajor:

The above referenced Consent Decree requires that the Evansville Water and Sewer Utility (Utility) "track, using an electronic data management system, operating and maintenance activities, including causes of SSOs, CSS releases and Building/Property Backups" by July 31, 2011.

The Utility uses Datastream 7i as the computerized maintenance management system (CMMS) to track the information listed. This CMMS was in place and being used prior to, and has been used since, finalization of the Consent Decree. Therefore, the purpose of this letter is to document that the July 31, 2011 requirement for a CMMS to be in place was met by the Utility. Additionally, the Utility has recently completed and request for proposals process and entered into an agreement with Azteca Systems to install and implement a new CMMS, CityWorks. The new system will replace Datastream 7i and should be in place by late spring 2012.
